During the 75th year celebration of CEAP, the Philippine Catholic Schools Standards (PCSS) for Basic Education was launched. This document guides the CEAP member schools on pursuing quality assurance as Catholic institutions in the Philippines. Immediately after this, the CEAP National Board resolved that a similar document be drafted. Since then, a Technical Working Group (TWG) for the PCSS Higher Education has been engaged by the association. The team has been working on the draft of the document for the last two years.

For the Initial roll-out of the PCSS for Higher Education, the TWG for PCSS-HE has prepared a series of Convocations for the School Heads of Catholic Higher Education Institutions. Below are its objectives:

- 1. To present the PCSS Standards and Benchmarks,
- 2. To elicit participation in the collaborative formulation of the PCSS for Higher Education,
- 3. To validate the draft of 25 Standards and 105 Benchmarks in focus group discussions.

The Catholic Educational Association of the Philippines (CEAP) is hereby inviting you to this initial roll-out which will be in three (3) runs, the 1st of April at the University of Santo Tomas for Luzon, the 12th of April at St. Paul University Iloilo for Visayas, and the 15th of April at Ateneo de Davao University for Mindanao.

The registration fee for CEAP member schools is PhP500 and PhP750 for non-member schools. Attached are the Program (Luzon, Visayas and Mindanao runs) together with the Confirmation Slip, and a payment procedure which includes the Bank and payment information on how to settle registration fees.
